By registering for this program, you will be able to take a variety of courses offered by 4 universities (Nagoya University, Gifu University, Nagoya Institute of Technology, Meijo University) throughout the year, **for free**. If you are considering finding a job in Japan, this is the program for you. We look forward to your active participation!

## Benefits of registering for our program

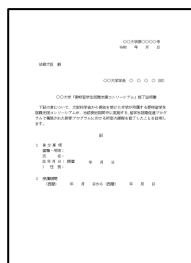
In this program, you receive points according to the number of your participation to various courses. When your points reach a certain number, we issue the **Certification** upon request. Please find required points as below.

- **Bachelor students need to obtain 15 points or more.**
- **Master's & Doctoral students need to obtain 7 points or more.**

In addition, with the **“Certificate for Completion of the Program”**, you will get preferential treatment for application procedure to change your residential status (simplified document submission and faster examination).

## Points applicable courses /activities

### Business Japanese Language Courses

1 Unit = 1 Point  
at least 80% attendance needed  
\*Total of 7 lessons → at least 6 attendances needed  
2 days intensive course → all 2-day attendance needed

### Career Development Courses + Job-hunting Events

1 Unit = 1 Point  
Continuous lectures → at least 80% attendance  
One-off lectures & events → 1 Point

### Internship

Participation in the job-hunting event = 1 Point  
Participation in internship →  
less than 1 week = 2 Points \*1 day = Additional review  
1 week or longer = 2 Points+ 2 Points per every week

### JLPT

Level 1 = 2 Points Level 2 = 1 Point

### Career Counseling

Regardless of the number of times you take session, you obtain 1 point only once for this activity.

**\*Remarks** : You need to submit designated documents to obtain points of Internship, Career Counseling, or JLPT (Points of these activities won't be added automatically.) The documents are distributed at Career Support Center, or available via e-mail upon request.
