

# All doctoral candidates! Application for the scholarship that supports outstanding researchers is open soon.

Nagoya University aims to cultivate “doctoral professionals who can pioneer interdisciplinary research areas, create future knowledge for social implementation, and act globally.” This scholarship provides excellent and aspiring students with financial support and opportunities to acquire various professional skills during the regular study period. The scholarship intends to encourage students with a doctoral degree to play a more active role in diverse fields of society.

The application for the scholarship includes additional openings (for current M2 & D1 students) in the "Interdisciplinary Frontier Fellowship" introduced April 2021 and the new "THERS Interdisciplinary Frontier Next Generation Researcher" scholarship (for current D1 to D3 students).

The official announcement of the scholarship application will come soon. This scholarship outline is for your information. (In both scholarships, applicants from the Graduate School of Medicine should be in one-year advanced class than other school applicants.)
